How they are assigned: age group, AR vs. Center
In Charge of Game: may stop/delay game if unruly parent or coach (report to be filed)
Do not question: direct questions to ref assignor after game
May *politely* ask: blow whistle longer/louder, indicate direction signals clearly.....
Yellow/Red Cards: reason and consequences
Follow League and State rules:
Mostly kids: *think* – would you ever want anybody to treat your child like ...
NRS will have offender removed if verbal or physical intimidation used

Fields – Rusty Boguskie – 10min

Practice: start date, days time, and location, allotted time and days, map on website
Practice area: correct location, ½marked field, between field areas (keep parents clear)
Lights: Field ?? if needed,
Not Allowed: pets, noisemakers, smoking, threats, or foul language.
Game Area: coaches box, player/coach sideline, opposite sideline (flag to
flag) parent viewing 3' from field.
Friday: Field C used for Open Academy and OA Adv.
Lightening Policy: see or hear off fields until 15 min or approved
Goals/Nets Area: STAY OFF and OUT, parent responsible for child

Coaches – Amanda DeWald – 10/15min

Contact player: *now-* your name, team name, practice time, date and location.

Description of self, clothing or sign helps locating

Sign: Coaches Code, Vol. Disclosure, Uniform Pick up, Practice Schedule,

Have: official team roster at practice and games, roster checks at games
only rostered players at practice and games.

Team mom – organize contact list, allergy/med list, end of year party,

Website – know and inform – www.nrssoccer.org

general rules, all board members, meetings, newsletter, coach development links,

1st aid guidelines, game schedules, game duration, field closures, game delay/cx.

Responsible: *conduct* of players and parents, send notice if having problem

not child - parents may not leave in your care

50% play is the policy: exceptions (better be documented!!!)

language/conduct, physically unable

Coach Guidelines: 1st parent meeting, practice outline, links

NRS: is recreational, we are here to emphasize how to play soccer not just win. Though no score is kept all need to learn how to be good sports on both sides of the known outcome.

Running up goals w/o setting up conditions to prevent is poor sportsmanship. Looking finding and focusing on only the negative is also poor sportsmanship

Rule/conduct violation: may receive 1 warning, probation, removal

temporarily or permanently from NRS depending on violation.

Chain of reporting: coach – coordinator - coach director - board - NRS meeting

During the game: send assist or parent for ref assign or board member

Incident Report: fill out and turn in on-line or in person

Incident Includes: practice/game, coach, ref, parent, player situation

Programs: mentors, Open Academy, Adv OA , Goalie, Ripples, Adult(Bernie/Sully)

SRFC (competitive division of NRS) – may contact coach then parent U8 & above with tryout information for team. Share and promote information
